



“Are you OK?” Program Waiver

Recipient of the “Are You OK?” program agrees to the following conditions to ensure the timely response of emergency personnel:

1. Law enforcement may first attempt to gain entry to the residence by nondestructive means.
 - a. Law enforcement may utilize a key held via a storage system if the recipient has on file with the “Are You OK?” program the location of the key and the means of access.
 - b. In the event that a key is not available, recipient agrees to hold harmless the responding office or agency, County of DeWitt and/or City of Clinton and/or City of Farmer City for any damage caused during the forced entry onto the premises and any subsequent damages that follow that are a result of the forced entry.
 - c. Recipient understands in the event of an exigency, law enforcement may not wait for information concerning non-forced entry and immediately proceed to forced entry.
2. Recipient acknowledges that use of this service does not create a duty upon any law enforcement entity outside of their current duties defined by the laws of the State of Illinois.
3. Recipient acknowledges that the “Are You OK?” program does not provide medical treatment of any kind, and that law enforcement personnel shall notify appropriate medical services on behalf of the recipient.
4. Law enforcement agrees to keep all information submitted to the “Are You OK?” program confidential, included but not limited to names, addresses, location of spare keys, security codes, telephone numbers, prescription information, and physician information.
 - a. In the event of a security breach law enforcement agrees to provide notice to recipients of the “Are You OK?” program of such breach.
 - b. Recipient agrees to hold harmless the responding office or agency, County of DeWitt and/or City of Clinton and/or City of Farmer City for any breach of security in their information system.
